The **SaltAS Salt Assurance scheme** has been developed to provide confidence to your customers. It is a recognised symbol of quality assurance for salt products. It provides assurance to businesses and consumers that participants work within a clear, consistent and auditable framework to ensure that all supplies of salt products comply with customer's quality requirements and expectations at all times.

Participation in the **SaltAS** scheme is entirely voluntary and open to all, but companies electing to participate will be required to meet the relevant standards and obligations to achieve certification. The **SaltAS** standard has been designed to cover the entire supply chain from production to delivery.

- Quality
- Service providers





SaltAS Salt has been designed in cooperation with PAI (Product Authentication International). It is not intended to replace or duplicate existing schemes. Conformance with recognised industry standards will count towards **SaltAS** certification.
